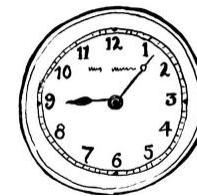

Faith based Curriculum

Our goal is to promote a relationship with God by reflecting on each individual's talents and gifts. Our goal will be achieved through the knowledge and skills the teachers have of the following curriculum:

Gospel Light: This curriculum provides a large variety of engaging activities for all ages to enjoy. It also gives scripture and faith based ideas to use in the classroom that will fit with the weekly themes.

Love & Logic: Our teachers will encourage children to make their own choices with love and empathy. "Children will learn best when you're given a task and allowed to make their own choices when the cost of failure is still small. Children's failures must be coupled with love and empathy from their parents and teachers."

Creative Curriculum: The teachers believe they should allow children to use their own creativity skills so that their creativity is not stifled. Children will have opportunities to build on their own interests and grow from the interests and talents of others in the class.

Policies and Procedures

Admission Procedures

At the time of registration, the following are due:

1. Registration Form
2. Enrollment Fee: \$15
3. Class fee: Early Registration (Now-June 19) \$35 per week
Late Registration \$45 per week

Enrollment/Cancellation Policy

Because we keep small class sizes, it is important to enroll as soon as possible. Registration is open for each class until the Wednesday before class starts or until it is full. Class will be canceled the week before if enrollment is too low. Families will be fully refunded for a canceled class, or they can switch to another week of class at no charge.

Drop off and Pick up

At drop off, parents will walk students down to the classroom – arrows will direct the way. At pick up time, the staff will bring the students to their parents in the main lobby. Students will only be dismissed to people listed on the registration form.

Dress code

Please dress your children in clothes that are appropriate for the weather and can get dirty, as we are ready to make a mess in the room!

Staff

Toilet Training

All children should be fully potty trained before attending this program. We must insist that all children are able to use the bathroom and provide self care independently. Teachers will, however, assist with difficult buttons or other clothing.
